

Televes, S.A.U. Environmental Performance

The environment in which Televes has grown has led to a constant concern for the environment, which has increased over the years due, among other reasons, to increasingly demanding environmental legislation.

In order to demonstrate this environmental commitment to all stakeholders, Televes' management decided to implement an Environmental Management System and have it certified by an external body, based on the ISO 14001:2015 standard.

In addition, taking advantage of the transition from ISO 9001:2008, which had already been implemented and certified in the company for years, to ISO 9001:2015, the two systems were integrated into what we call the Integrated Management System.

In 2019, ISO 45001:2018 for Occupational Health and Safety was incorporated into this Integrated Management System and, in 2022, the Energy Management System was also integrated in accordance with the guidelines of ISO 50001:2018.

Environmental aspects

The process for identifying environmental aspects and impacts is carried out comprehensively for all Televes, S.A.U. activities, products and services, considering a life-cycle perspective and normal, abnormal and emergency operating conditions.

The environmental aspects identified and their corresponding impacts include:

Periodic reviews are carried out to detect new obligations that will lead to the appropriate corrective actions to ensure compliance.

To assess the environmental performance of our organization, we take into account:

- Non-conformities and corrective actions
- Results of environmental monitoring and measurement indicators
- Degree of compliance with legal and other requirements
- Results of internal and external audits
- Results of periodic emergency preparedness and response tests
- Actions arising from operational control
